Reaching One Milestone at a Time

For six excited and glowing fifth-grader students from Sunshine Cottage, the passage from elementary school began Wednesday morning at 8:15 a.m. June 16 when they marched into the gym for the final time to the sounds of "Pomp and Circumstance."

They walked up one by one to accept signed certificates, pausing for a grip-and-grin shot with their teacher. They each spoke expressively about their future hopes and dreams.

"It's a memorable time for our students," said Deputy Director-Principal Fred Hayes, as parents began reviewing the program adorned with a photo of their child and a brief history of their careers at Sunshine Cottage.



This year's ceremony was scaled down because of COVID restraints, but it did not stop the celebration of their success. "We wanted to make sure to commemorate this wonderful time honored tradition," said Principal Hayes. The ceremony was also live streamed via Facebook Live so every staff member, student, and family member could watch the ceremony. This year's ceremony ended a little differently. Following the assembly, the fifth-grade graduates left campus to share in one last Sunshine experience at Andretti's Indoor Karting & Games, marking their last day as a Sunshine Cottage student.

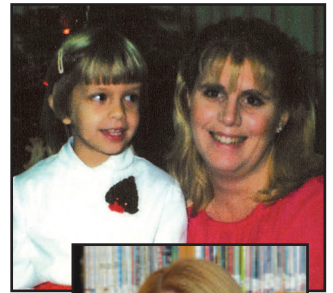
Congrats

For the safety of all involved, therapy was almost 100 percent virtual for the entire school year. This came with the following benefits:

- Working virtually matched perfectly the way we conduct therapy through coaching families;
- Attendance improved overall by 10 percent with a program average of 96 percent for the year; and
- Therapists and parents alike became even more creative and learned many new skills.

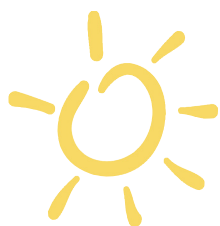

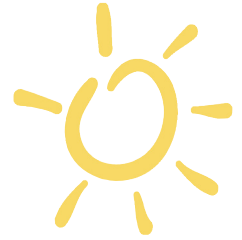
