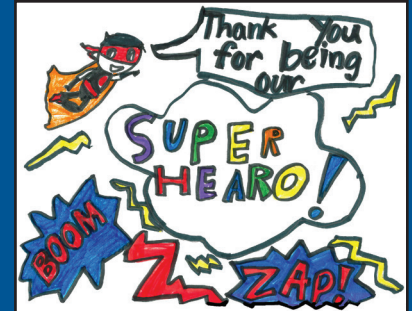

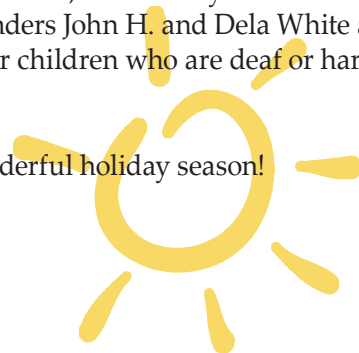

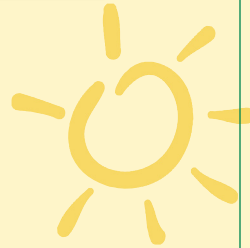

A CLASSROOM PROJECT: A Tale of a Fateful Trip



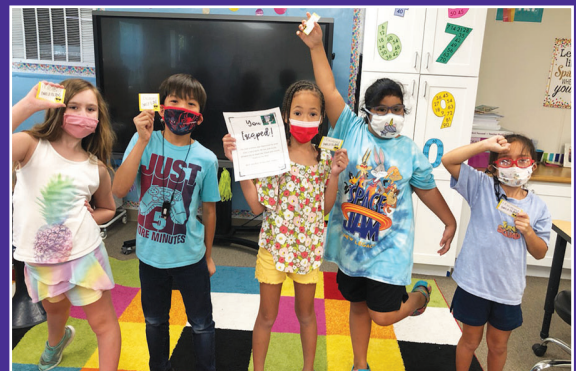
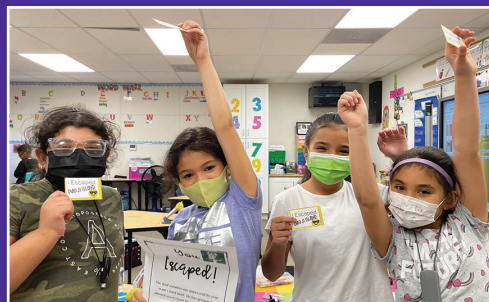
